## Losing your job does not mean losing your home

**Keep Your Home California** is a federally-funded foreclosure prevention program that may be able to help you. Up to \$3,000 in monthly mortgage help is available for qualified unemployed homeowners for as long as eighteen months.

You may be eligible for this mortgage assistance if:

- You own and occupy your home in California
- You received unemployment benefits from EDD within the past 30 days
- Your current loan balance is under \$729,750
- Your mortgage servicer participates
